RECIPE

WHITE AND DARK CHOCOLATE TIRAMISU

Ingredients:-

100g white chocolate, roughly chopped
300ml thickened cream - 2 eggs
1/4 cup (55g) caster sugar
500g mascarpone cheese
150ml prepared strong espresso coffee, cooled
100ml Kahlua (or other coffee liqueur)
24 sponge finger biscuits (savoiardi)
250g fresh (or frozen) raspberries (thawed)

Method:-

Place white chocolate in a heat proof bowl over a pan of simmering water (don't let the bowl touch the water).

Allow to melt, then stir very gently until smooth.

Set melted chocolate aside to cool slightly. Meanwhile, whip cream to soft peaks, then fold in cooled chocolate.

In a separate bowl, whisk eggs and 2tbs sugar using electric beaters until pale, then whisk in mascarpone.

Carefully fold a quarter of the chocolate cream into the mascarpone mixture, then fold in remaining chocolate.

Cover and refrigerate.

Combine coffee, Kahlua and remaining 1tbs sugar in a shallow dish. One at a time briefly dip 8 sponge fingers in coffee mixture and lay in a row on a platter. Spread half the mascarpone mixture on top, then scatter with half the berries.

Top with another 8 dipped sponge fingers, remaining mascarpone and berries, followed by remaining 8 dipped sponge fingers.

Cover loosely and chill for at least 2 hours or overnight.

Chocolate sauce:-

300g good quality dark chocolate, chopped
300ml pure (thin) cream.

Place chocolate in a bowl. Place cream in a pan over medium heat and bring to just below boiling point.

Pour over chocolate and stir until smooth.

To serve, drizzle tiramisu with sauce and cut into 8 slices.
