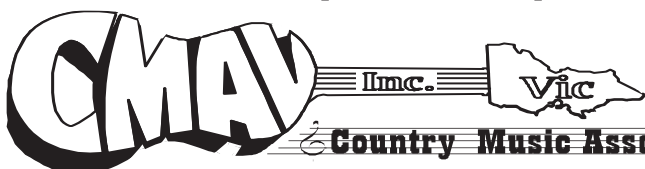

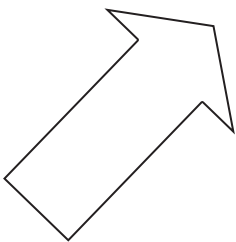

**provide 3 copies of words, music and/or chords for each item they intend to perform.**

**This is in the interest of each performer.**



## **CMAV CLUB RULES**

### **“These are NO-NO’S”**

# Welcome to our 199th Club night



OUR GUEST ARTIST TONIGHT IS-

## CAMERON MASON

"Growing up in Bendigo, Central Victoria, Cameron was never far from the sounds of country music in the family home. His early favourites were Hank Williams, Charlie Pride, Don Williams and Merle Haggard, and they gave him the motivation to pick up a guitar at the age of nine and begin to sing.

Realising right from the beginning that music would play a major role in his life, Cam started writing his own songs and formed a band at the age of twelve. The band worked all over the state.

Cameron and his band relocated to Sydney where they worked consistently on the live scene playing support to many of the top acts, such as Goanna, John Paul Young, and international act "Hot Chocolate". After eleven gruelling years on the circuit, the band finally decided to call it quits, with the exception of Cameron. With music still running deep in his veins Cameron was determined to continue to follow his dream.

After receiving a John Williamson Telstra encouragement award, Cam entered the Starmaker Quest in Tamworth, became a finalist and formed "Runaway Train". The new band won Tamworth's Jim Beam Battle of the Bands competition, received a Golden Guitar nomination, and had a top ten single with "Nothin' that a little bit of you can't cure". In the years following, Cameron has toured from Cooktown in the far North of Queensland down to Burnie in Tasmania. He has performed regularly at all the leading Festivals, such as Charters Towers, Wagga, Gympie, Tamworth, etc. He is an easy going country guy with a great voice so you are in for a good night's entertainment. Cameron eventually re-settled in his home town of Bendigo, returned to his songwriting, and produced another 2 CDs called "Changes" and "Timeless", and already has another in the pipeline.

Welcome back Cameron.

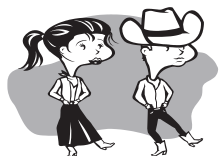

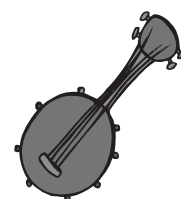

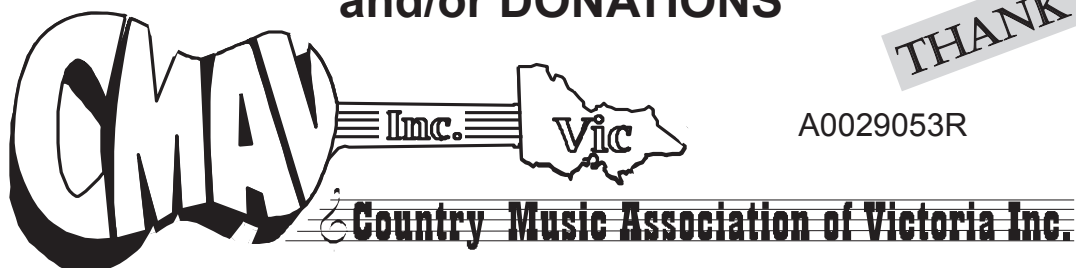
