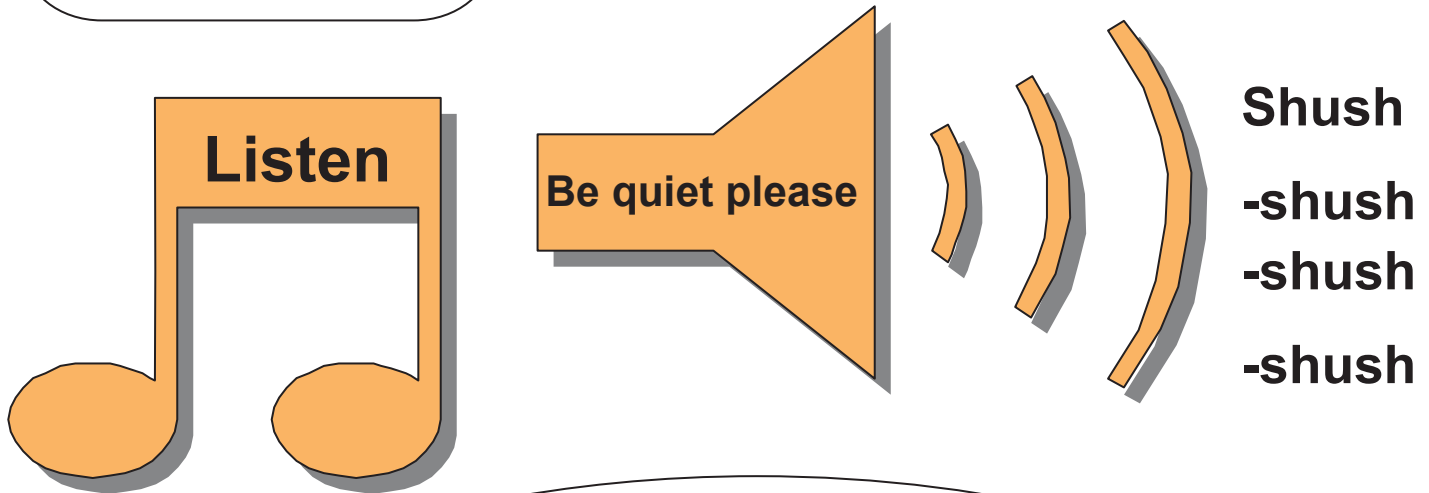
“These are NO-NO’S”

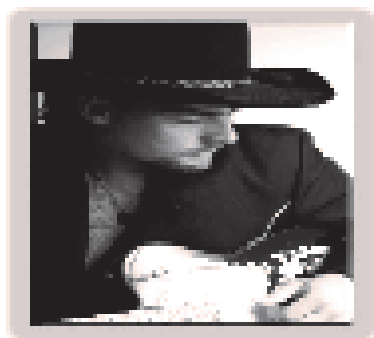

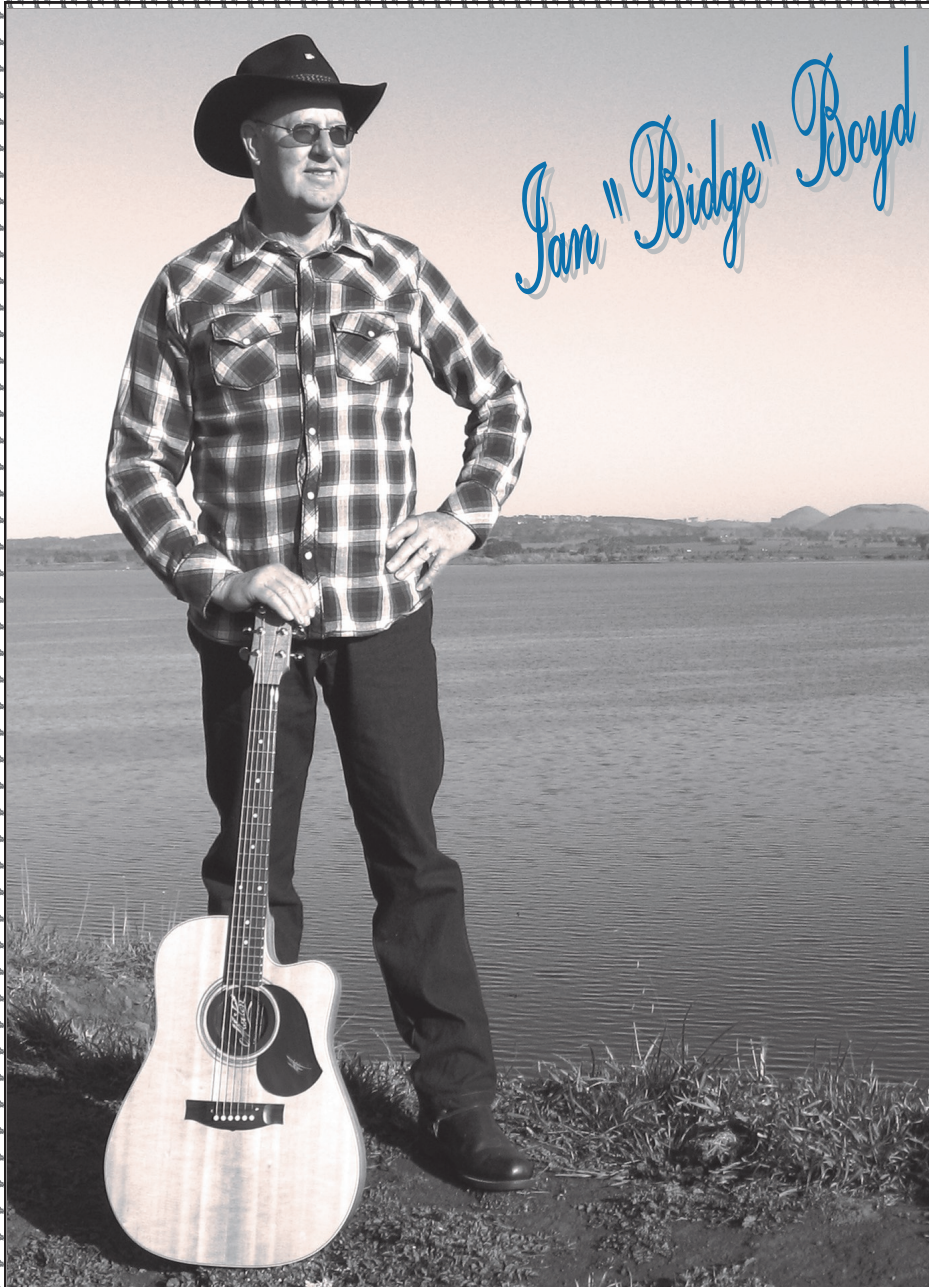

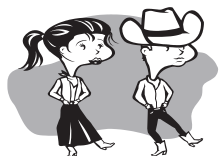

C.M.A.V. 200th Club Night NOSTALGIA

In the very early 'Nineties' Norm Whitton and Gordon Vincent did a few gigs of country music out at Kryal Castle. After about 18 months of this, Norm credits Gordon Vincent with the idea of forming a Country Music Club. With some planning and plenty of organizing, the Country Music Association of Victoria was born, and those of us who today, reap the benefits of that thought, can only be thankful.

The Club was formed on 8th January, 1994

The first Club Night was on 10th April, 1994

The Venue was The Club Hotel, in Clunes.

The opening night was apparently a great success.

The Club has continued to grow steadily, and we now have over 200 paid up members. It was decided at the beginning to make the Club a non-profit organization, and to donate the monies to local needy charities.

Our Club continues to be successful and popular. Those of us who take up voluntary positions on the Committee do so for the love of the Club and because we love the music. All our volunteers as well as our members and patrons are there for the same reasons, and your loyalty is always appreciated.

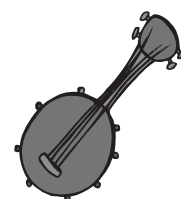

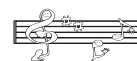
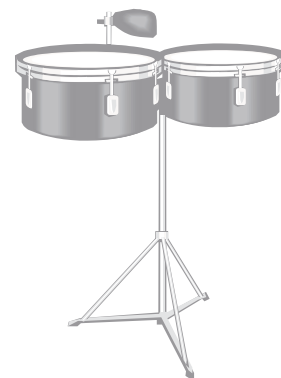

A reasonable percentage of our current members and patrons will be able to recall the early years of the Club, certainly more than me. A few of those details are on page 16. I have been able to .contact some of the early Committee members, and if possible, they will join us tonight. We are all going to share a lovely celebration cake to mark the occasion. Dennis and I have actually managed to visit some of the many Clubs and functions that have been happening over the last six weeks. Firstly we went to the Warrnambool & District C.M. Club. There we caught up with country music friends that we have not seen for ages. It was a great afternoon, and we were given a very warm welcome. 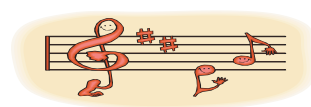

RECIPE

Lime Delicious

(serves 6)

Preparation 15mins - Cooking 40mins

This recipe must be made close to serving time.

It is not suitable to freeze or microwave.

Ingredients:

30g softened butter - 1 tsp grated lime rind

1/2 cup (110g) caster sugar

3 eggs separated - 1/4 cup (35g) plain flour

1 cup (250ml) milk

1/2 cup (125ml) lime juice - 1 egg white extra

Icing sugar for dusting

Method:

Preheat oven to moderate (180°C).

Grease a deep 1.25Litre

(5 cup) capacity ovenproof dish.

Beat butter, rind, sugar and egg yolks in a small bowl with an electric mixer until mixture is creamy.

Beat in sifted flour and juice, then gradually beat in milk.

In a clean small mixing bowl, beat the 4 egg whites until firm peaks form; fold through the lime mixture.

Pour the mixture into the prepared dish.

Place dish in larger baking dish containing cold water to come halfway up the sides of the dish.

Bake for 40mins or until browned and just firm.

Dust with sifted icing sugar and serve immediately with cream or ice-cream, if desired.

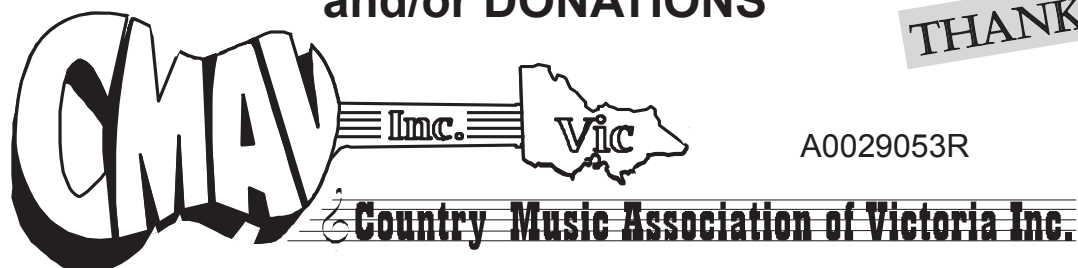
