“I came from a large family of nine, (six brothers and two sisters). As a youngster, my siblings and I were always encouraged to listen and dance to music. At 12 years of age, I told my father I would like to learn to play the guitar. That is when I got the taste of really enjoying my music. For the next two years, he would always take to once weekly for my guitar lessons. It was then, that I first played and sang solo to a rather large crowd. As scary as it was, it was also very rewarding to find out that people actually enjoyed me entertaining them with my music.

Two of my brothers played the guitar one played drums and the other played the trumpet. You could imagine the jam sessions we had. At sixteen I became the lead vocalist in a band with my brother and some of his friends. We played at weddings, engagements, social functions, etc. At the same time I was also singing and playing in the young church choir.

At eighteen years of age I got married and my priority became my family life and children. Sadly my music was put aside for 19 years playing the role of housewife and mother. Then I picked up on my music again and the love of entertaining. I decided I would try to get serious about it.

I have attended and performed at as many of the country music venues as I could. I have had guest artist spots at Echuca, Solar City, Mooropna, Kyabram, Tongala and Geelong. I have performed at many Clubs and pubs (too many to mention) and am now looking forward to coming to Ballarat.

I find music extremely satisfying and I can honestly say that if I can see people dancing and enjoying the songs that I sing, then I enjoy doing it all the more. Thank you for the privilege of allowing me to perform at your club.” Chrissy

Guest artist at "Morning Melodies" this month was George Farnham. He has a great personality - the capacity crowd really liked him and his choice of covers and traditional music.

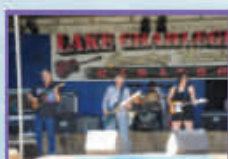
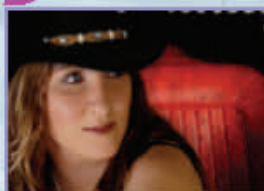

RECIPE

Rhubarb and Pear sponge pudding.

Ingredients:

825g can pear slices - 2 tbs caster sugar - 2 eggs
800g rhubarb, trimmed and cut into 4cm pieces
1/3 (75g) caster sugar extra - 2 tbs plain flour
2 tbs self raising flour - 2 tbs cornflour

Method:

1. Preheat oven to 180°C/160°C fan forced.
2. Drain pears; reserve 3/4 cup (180ml) of the juice.
3. Place reserved juice, rhubarb and sugar in a large saucepan; cook stirring occasionally, about 5 mins or until rhubarb is just tender. Stir in pears. Pour mixture into deep 1.75 - litre (7cup) ovenproof dish.
4. Meanwhile, beat eggs in a small bowl with electric mixer until thick and creamy. Gradually add extra sugar, 1 tablespoon at a time, beating until sugar dissolves between additions.
Gently fold in combined sifted flours.
5. Spread sponge mixture over hot rhubarb mixture. Bake about 45 mins or until browned lightly and cooked through.

Note:- *Preparation and cooking time 1hour & 10mins.*

Serves six.

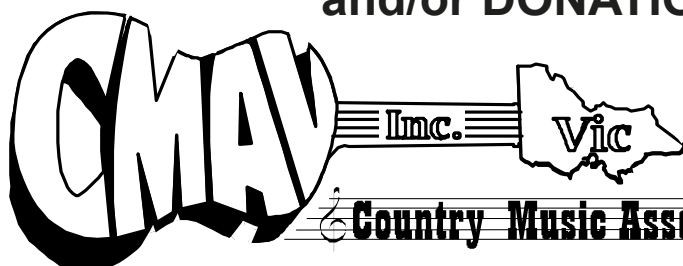
