RECIPE

Chocolate Fudge Pudding

This recipe is a favourite of Karen Lynne. Karen is a young country and bluegrass entertainer from the Blue Mountains in N.S.W. She and her partner are very keen to visit our Club in the not-too-distant future. Here is her recipe:-

Ingredients:-

1 cup S.R. flour - 1/2 tsp salt - 1/2 cup sugar
1 1/2 tbsp cocoa powder - 1/2 cup milk
1 tsp vanilla - 1 egg - 2 tbsp melted butter

Extra topping:-

1/4 cup cocoa - 1/4 cup sugar - 2 cups hot water

Method:-

Mix together, salt, sugar and cocoa. Add milk, unbeaten egg and melted butter. Mix until smooth.

Pour into an ovenproof dish and sprinkle top with extra cocoa and sugar, then carefully pour over hot water. (Do not stir). Bake in a moderate oven until firm on top (about 40 to 50 mins).

Serve hot with ice cream. Serves 4.

Karen is a hopeless chocoholic so her recipe could be about nothing else, but like her favourite country songs, it is traditional and most enjoyable.
