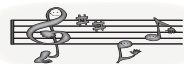

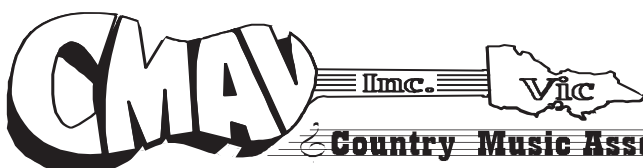

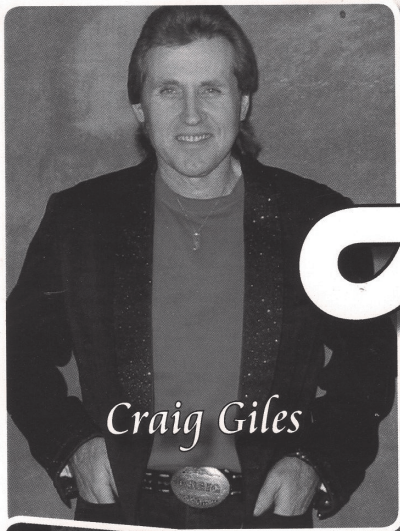

Trevor Keilar



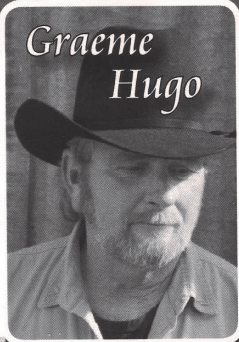

RECIPE

PEARL COUSCOUS, PEAS & POTATO.

At all the CMAV Barbeques we are treated to some really delightful dishes. This particular one raised a fair amount of interest, so here it is -

Carolyn Swanton style.

Thanks Carolyn for sharing this with us.

Ingredients

- ◆ **1 pkt of Pearl couscous - 3/4 cup of peas**
- ◆ **1 large potato (add more or less if desired)**
- ◆ **2 tsp cumin**
- ◆ **1 tsp turmeric**
- ◆ **1/2 tsp sweet paprika**
- ◆ **2 tsp Massel vegie or chicken stock powder.**
- ◆ **Braggs sauce to taste.**

Method

- 1. Boil peas and diced peeled potatoes until just cooked then drain.**
- 2. Put the Pearl couscous in boiling water & boil until just cooked then drain.**
- 3. In a pan, fry some diced onion & crushed garlic in olive oil until transparent. Add turmeric, cumin and sweet paprika.**
- 4. Stir constantly for a few moments until the aromas begin to come forth.**
- 5. Add peas, potato and couscous and stir through the spices.**
- 6. Add some Massel stock powder and some Braggs all-purpose seasoning to taste (if you haven't any Braggs, soy sauce will be OK)**

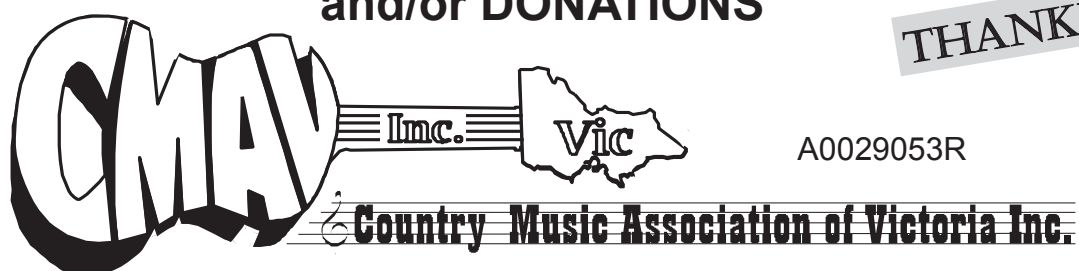
