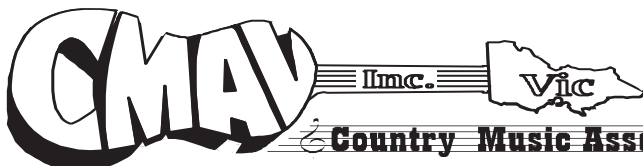

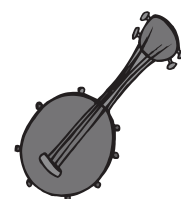

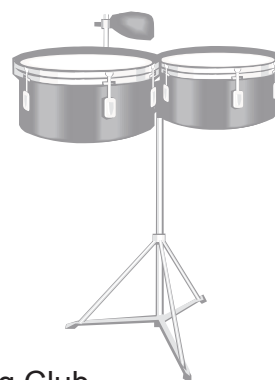

RECIPE

INGREDIENTS

Tray of Vanilla Ice Cream
1/4 Cup of Sugar
1 1/2 Cups Biscuit Crumbs
1/4 Cup Butter
1/2 Cup Raspberry Jam

METHOD

Mix biscuit crumbs, butter, and sugar until well blended. Press this mixture on the bottom and round the sides of a refrigerator tray and set in fridge for 30 minutes.

Stir the ice cream until slightly softened and put into crumb lined tray, then swirl the jam through the ice cream.

Put back in fridge to set. When ready to serve, cut the pie into wedges.

- Coffee flavouring with Choc Nuts
- Cocoa, with pieces of peppermint brittle
- Bourneville
- Strawberry flavouring with chopped cherries
- Almond flavouring with peanuts
