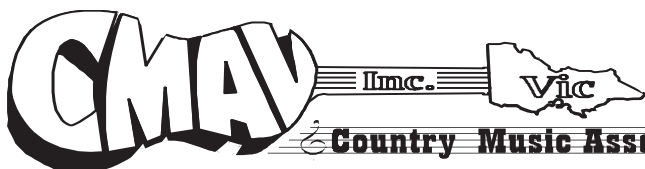

Tribute To One Lovely Lady

Over the years that I knew Doris Lawrence. I listened with much interest to stories about her very interesting life, and I was constantly in awe of her incredible memory. She was born on the 9th February, 1921 at Glen Park. She had seven sisters and nine brothers - how many parents these days could cope with a family of that size?! They all attended the Glen Park School and the local Sunday School.

Doris helped her Mum at home, and became well-known for her baking. The family had their own cows and hens, and grew their own vegies.

Doris was 15 yrs old when she began to work, and just 17 yrs old when she met Frank, her husband-to be. They were married in 1942, and had 3 daughters - Evelyn, Carol (deceased) and Cheryl. She and Frank were busy until Frank retired. They both enjoyed lawn bowls, indoor bowls, and they taught ballroom and New Vogue dancing for years. They also ran a nursery from home, growing Fuchsias and Ferns. When Frank passed away, Doris joined the Black Hill Senior Citizens and continued to play bowls. One of her great loves was country music, and daughter Evelyn happily took her to Sebastopol, Beaufort and Ballarat Clubs, and it was at the CMAV that I met Doris. Sadly, this lovely lady passed away on 12th December 2012, and she is already missed by all who knew her. I feel privileged to have been one of those persons, I will cherish the times we talked together.

She was proud of her daughters, her 16 grandchildren, 41 great grandchildren and 12 great- great grand children and they are most definitely proud of her, with good reason.

Our very sincere and warm wishes to Evelyn & Max, Aimee & Leigh, and all the family. The CMAV can never be the same without her presence.

RECIPE

Cauliflower, Potato and Pea mash.

Gluten free & Lower Sodium

Ingredients:

1/2 large (600g) head cauliflower, roughly chopped.

2 large (350) Sebago potatoes, peeled & roughly chopped.

**1/2 cup frozen peas - 2 tablespoons milk
20g butter - 2/3 cup grated pecorino cheese.**

Method:

Place cauliflower and potato in a large pan. Cover with cold water. Bring to the boil over high heat. Cook for 15 - 20mins or until vegetables are tender adding peas in the last two minutes of cooking.

Drain Well.

Return vegetables to pan over low heat. Toss for one minute or until excess liquid has evaporated. Mash until smooth. Stir in milk, butter and cheese. Season with salt and pepper. Serve.
