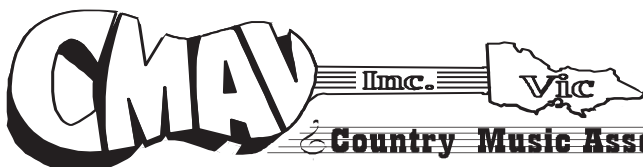

Bill walked into the Bellarine Country Music Club in February of 2012 and sang a couple of songs that he had written. He continued to visit the club every Friday and it soon became quite clear that he really wanted to achieve something with his music. He came to have coffee with Caroline and me and we suggested a few popular country songs that he might like to learn. He learned them and sang them rather well, so we then invited him to our practice session.. It seemed fairly obvious that Bill had a great voice, a ton of talent and a great work ethic..In no time at all he was able to learn new material, so I then took him to the next Cobden country music night and he sang so well that Col McGillivray offered him a guest spot the following month. He learned enough songs to fill two half hour spots, and performed exceptionally well on the night.

Bill has continued to improve and learn new material and now has more than one hundred songs under his belt, not bad for someone who knew only two songs just twelve months ago.!!!Bill's next project was to put a CD together. This was produced by the very talented Darryl Weckert and recorded and mastered by DMW in Ballarat.. Bill sings some country standards as well as covering artists as diverse as Elvis, Kris Kristofferson, Johnny Cash , The Eagles and many others. It is a good CD.

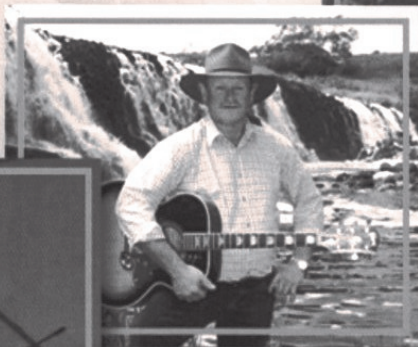

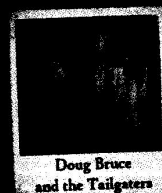

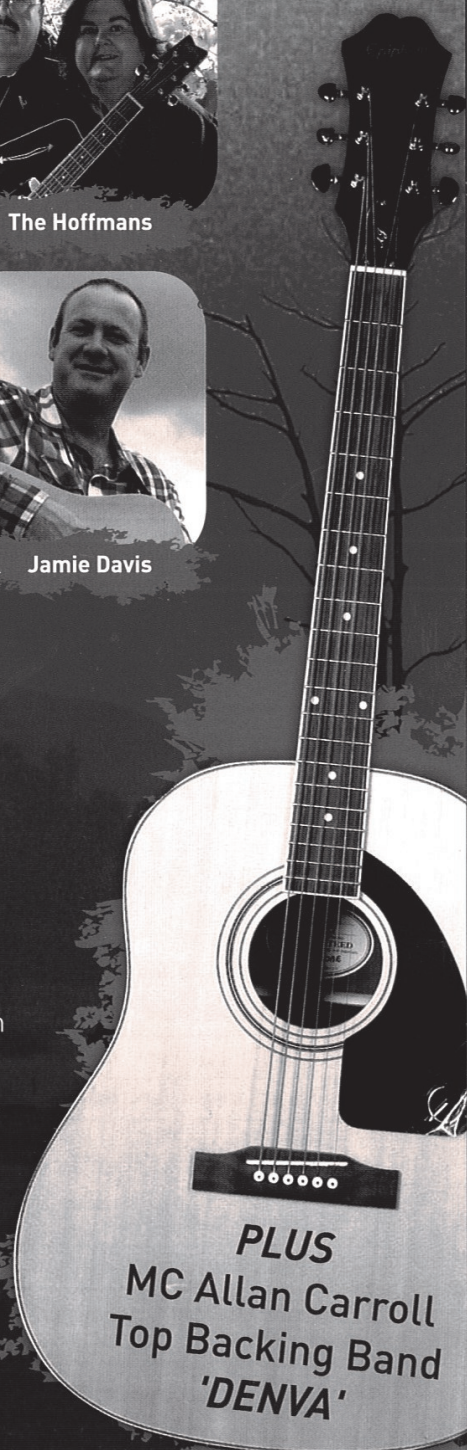

Variety concert for Tasmanian relief

SOME of Ballarat's most talented performers will be on show next month to help raise funds for those affected by the Tasmanian bushfires.

Local singers and dancers will perform in a variety concert held at Ballarat and District Trotting Club on February 22 to help raise funds for the Red Cross Tasmanian bushfire appeal.

Organiser Ammie Moneghetti said the concert would offer something for everyone. "The concert is an opportunity for people to feel like they are contributing to the effort, just by attending," she said.

"It is important for those effected by this tragedy to know they have support. We urge people to come along, knowing that by their attendance they are helping the cause. Every single dollar counts."

After the 2009 Victorian bushfires, Ms Moneghetti organised a concert in Colac which raised \$4500 for the Red Cross appeal, and is hoping to do the same this year in Ballarat.

"Seeing the devastation in the print media and on television, and the deep hurt on the faces of those effected was very upsetting. I just want to help in some way," Ms Moneghetti said.

There will also be raffles and auctions on the night.

RECIPE

Bacon and Mushroom Cream Slice.

Ingredients:

- 1 egg yolk lightly beaten - 2 sheets of ready rolled shortcrust pastry**
- 2 tbsp oil - 3 cups (375g) finely chopped mushrooms**
- 4 rashers of bacon finely chopped - 4 spring onions finely chopped**
- ¼ cup finely chopped parsley - salt & pepper to taste**
- 250g cream cheese softened - 3 eggs, plus 1 egg white**

Method:

Preheat oven to moderately hot 210°C (190°C gas). Brush a shallow 23cm sq cake tin with melted butter or oil. Brush yolk over one sheet of pastry. Place second sheet over first; press together gently. Trim pastry edges to fit tin. Prick pastry evenly with a fork. Bake 15min, remove from oven. Heat oil in heavy base pan. Add mushroom and stir over medium heat for 10mins or until mushrooms are well browned. Remove pan from heat. Stir in bacon, spring onions, and parsley. Season to taste and allow to cool. Using electric beaters, beat cheese and egg in a small mixing bowl on medium speed for 5mins. Add cooled mushroom mixture; stir to combine. Pour mixture on to partly cooked pastry base. Bake for 25mins or until firm and lightly browned. Cool in tin then cut into 18 triangles. Hint: It may be served as a savoury slice for morning tea, or cut into larger pieces and served with salad for brunch.
