

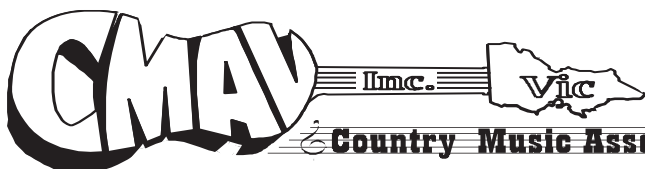

Bruce is a country boy, who grew up on his parents dairy farm in Warrion, He always had a deep seated love of music, and in 1964, still a teenager, he joined a local Colac band called "Playmates", with influence by The Shadows, and The Beatles, etc. For 13 years the band played at dances, cabarets and local functions. Bruce moved to Geelong in 1977 to join a 5 piece band "The Squires" and for 14 years, they played in Melbourne, Geelong, at Corporate functions, and dances and they proved to be very popular. Bruce was re-introduced to country music through the Colac Comeback Country Music Club. He was President for a time until he was asked to join Billy Bridges "Hillbilly Heat" and toured with this band for 2 years. Bill introduced him to Lee Forster, and the past 9 years with Lee and his band have seen him travel all over Australia - East, West, North and South, playing at Clubs, Corporate functions, and major Festivals. Bruce now lives in Enfield, not far from Ballarat and is married to the lovely Beriniece and both are members of our Club. He feels very lucky and has appreciated all the musical experiences he has had along the way. He owes a lot to the CM.A.V - he was part of the "Backtrackers" band, along with PJ, our drummer, Bidge Boyd, guitar and vocals, and Ken Atkinson, trumpet and vocals. When Bidge left, Andrew McLeish joined - Andrew now plays in the St. Arnaud Club band. Bruce is a talented musician, with a down-to-earth, laid back personality.

RECIPE

LEMON SPONGE

Ingredients:

**Tbsp butter - Cup sugar - grated rind and juice of 1 lemon
2 tbsp Self Raising flour - 2 eggs - Cup milk**

Method:

Mix butter with sugar, add juice and rind of lemon, then flour. Pour well beaten yolks of egg into cup of milk and mix well and mix well with other ingredients. Fold in stiffly beaten whites of the eggs. Put into a greased pie-dish and bake in a moderate oven 35 mins. Can be eaten hot or cold with custard or cream.

LEMON PUDDING

Ingredients:

**2 eggs - cup of sugar - juice and rind of a lemon
2 tbsp cornflour - small piece of butter (size of a walnut)**

Method:

Beat the egg yolks with half the sugar - add lemon and add blended cornflour. Stir into it a pint of boiling water (use an enamel pie-dish or basin for if it does not thicken it can be put back on the stove), stirring all the time until it cooks. Beat the whites of eggs to a stiff froth. Pour in the other half of sugar and pile on the top of the pudding. Put on lower shelf of oven and cook to a fawn colour. Serve either hot or cold. A delicious pudding.
