RECIPE

Judy's Cream Powder Puffs. (40pcs)

Ingredients:

**3x50g free range eggs @ room temperature
3/4 cup caster sugar
1/2 cup Plain flour - 1/2 cup cornflour
2 tsp baking powder - 450ml thickened cream
1 tsp vanilla essence
1/4 cup pure icing sugar**

Method:

Preheat oven to 200°C. Position oven shelf in centre of oven. Line 3 large flat baking trays with baking paper.

Using an electric mixer, beat eggs and sugar on high speed for 8 minutes or until pale and thick. Sift flours and baking powder over egg mixture. Fold in gently until just combined.

Drop 8 heaped teaspoonfuls of mixture onto 1 tray, allowing plenty of room for spreading. Bake for 4 to 6 minutes or until sponges are light golden and firm to touch. Allow to cool on tray. Remove to a wire rack.

Repeat until all mixture is cooked.

Using an electric mixer, whip cream until thick. Stir in vanilla and 2 tbsp icing sugar. Whip until thick again. Sandwich two sponge rounds together with whipped cream. Repeat with remaining sponge rounds and cream. Place in an airtight container, with baking paper between each layer. Refrigerate for 6 hours until soft to touch. Dust with remaining icing sugar just before serving.
