## **OUR SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING BIENNIAL MEETING.**

### **This is an extract from our proposed new “Constitution” draft.**

#### 16.3. Nomination and election

- (a) Nominations for candidates for election as Committee Members must:
  - (i) be made in writing, signed by two (2) members of the Association and endorsed with the consent of the nominee; and
  - (ii) be delivered to the Secretary not less than seven (7) days before the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting. Late nominations will only be accepted where no other nomination has been received for a particular vacancy.
- (b) Members may nominate for more than one position on the Committee but once a member is elected to a particular position, all other nominations by that member are automatically withdrawn.
- (c) If insufficient nominations are received to fill all vacancies on the Committee:
  - (i) the candidates nominated shall be deemed to have been elected to the positions for which they have been nominated (and a declaration to this effect may be made by the chairperson of the Annual General Meeting); and
  - (ii) nominations for the remaining positions shall be declared vacant.
- (d) If the number of nominations is equal to the number of vacancies, the persons nominated shall be deemed to have been elected and a declaration to this effect may be made by the Chairperson of the Annual General Meeting.
- (e) If the number of nominations exceeds the number of vacancies to be filled, a ballot must be taken at the Annual General Meeting.
- (f) The Committee (as in office immediately prior to the commencement of the Meeting) shall determine the method of any ballot required.

# **RECIPE**

Recently I have been asked if I have any recipes that are very quick and very easy to prepare. At short notice, below is the result, but I would happily accept and print any recipes from interested members/patrons of our Club.

## **Fried Rice.**

### **Ingredients:**

**2 cups of cooked rice - 1 cup of peas - 100g bacon pieces  
2 eggs - bean shoots - 2 chicken stock cubes - 1 chopped onion**

### **Method:**

**Brown bacon and onions in a frying pan and add crumbled stock cubes. Add rice, bean shoots and cooked peas. Lightly beat eggs and cook in a separate pan, cut into pieces and add to rice mixture. Heat through and serve. Rice can be cooked the day before and the peas can be frozen. If frozen peas are used then place the peas in a cup and pour boiling water over the top twice and the peas should thaw. Drain and use.**

## **Imitation Quiche.**

### **Ingredients:**

**4 beaten eggs - 4 ozs grated cheese  
1 finely chopped onion  
1 tbsp chopped parsley - 1/2 cup Self - raising flour  
1 1/2 cups of milk - 1 chopped tomato**

### **Method:**

**Lightly grease a flan plate. Mix everything in a bowl and pour into the flan plate.  
Cook for 3/4 hour at 180° - 200° degrees.**
