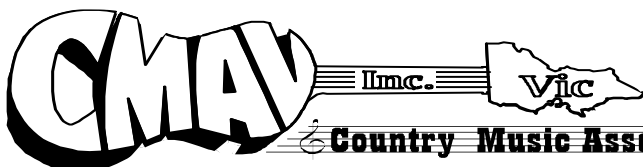

Growing up in Bendigo, Central Victoria, Cameron was never far from the sounds of country music in the family home. His early favourites were Hank Williams, Charlie Pride, Don Williams and Merle Haggard, and they gave him the motivation to pick up a guitar at the age of nine and begin to sing.

Realizing right from the beginning that music would play a major role in his life, Cam started writing his own songs and formed a band at the age of twelve. The band worked all over the state.

Cameron and his band relocated to Sydney where they worked consistently on the live scene playing support to many of the top acts, such as Goanna, John Paul Young, and international act "Hot Chocolate". After eleven gruelling years on the circuit, they finally decided to call it quits, with the exception of Cameron.

With music still running deep in his veins Cameron was determined to continue to follow his dream.

After receiving a John Williamson Telstra encouragement award, Cameron entered the Starmaker Quest in Tamworth, became a finalist and formed "Runaway Train". The new band won Tamworth's Jim Beam Battle of the Bands competition, received a Gold Guitar nomination, and had a top ten single with "Nothin' that a little bit of you can't cure"

The following years saw Cameron touring around most of the country including appearances regularly at Tamworth, the Gympie Muster, charters Towers Festival, and in many places from Burnie in Tasmania to Cooktown in QLD. He lived in New Zealand for a time when attending to some family issues, then with a return to his home town of Bendigo came a return to his songwriting which has resulted in CD's such as "Changes" "Timeless" and "Road Back Home". He is a born musician and the personality to match.

He is a full time disability worker, and has a very supportive wife in Shannon.

A very warm welcome to Cameron.

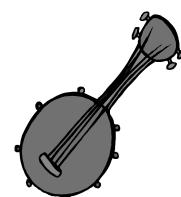
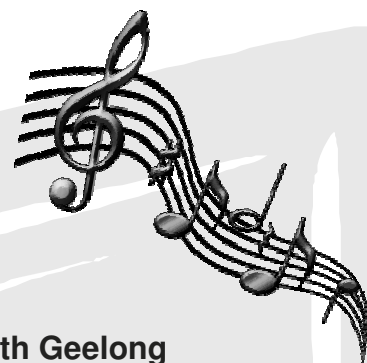

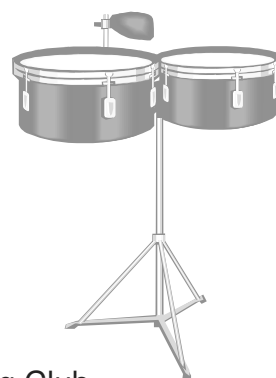

OUR SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING BIENNIAL MEETING.

This is an extract from our proposed new “Constitution” draft.

16.3. Nomination and election

- (a) Nominations for candidates for election as Committee Members must:
 - (i) be made in writing, signed by two (2) members of the Association and endorsed with the consent of the nominee; and
 - (ii) be delivered to the Secretary not less than seven (7) days before the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting. Late nominations will only be accepted where no other nomination has been received for a particular vacancy.
- (b) Members may nominate for more than one position on the Committee but once a member is elected to a particular position, all other nominations by that member are automatically withdrawn.
- (c) If insufficient nominations are received to fill all vacancies on the Committee:
 - (i) the candidates nominated shall be deemed to have been elected to the positions for which they have been nominated (and a declaration to this effect may be made by the chairperson of the Annual General Meeting); and
 - (ii) nominations for the remaining positions shall be declared vacant.
- (d) If the number of nominations is equal to the number of vacancies, the persons nominated shall be deemed to have been elected and a declaration to this effect may be made by the Chairperson of the Annual General Meeting.
- (e) If the number of nominations exceeds the number of vacancies to be filled, a ballot must be taken at the Annual General Meeting.
- (f) The Committee (as in office immediately prior to the commencement of the Meeting) shall determine the method of any ballot required.

The C.M.A.V. Constitution

For well over a year now, we have been slowly but surely updating our Club Constitution, which had not been altered since the very first days of the Club. As promised here is a further notification of our progress. It is a lengthy procedure and it is a legal one. I am very grateful to our very patient and helpful solicitor. However President Don has done a final reading and the document should be ready for publication very soon. Thanks for your interest and your patience.

POSSIBLE VENUE CHANGE

At almost every Committee meeting over the past 12 months, the issue about the CMAV venue has been raised. I think quite a few members and patrons are aware of the fact that a few months back, the rent for our CMAV Club night venue has been raised - it has gone from \$125.00 to \$250.00, and now \$500.00 - rent for the second Sunday evening of each month. Listening to members of the Committee, there are reasons why we should consider a change of venue, but there are just as many reasons why we should stay where we are, and continue to pay the nominated rent of \$500.00 per month. So, last month we invited you to give us your opinions re this particular problem and about any other issues that might be a cause for concern. Letters have been sent to the Committee about the water, the poor sound, too loud or not loud enough, the small dance floor, and the lack of air conditioning. Questionnaires were placed on the tables, and members and patrons were asked to fill them in, and I was delighted to have over 70 forms returned to the Committee at the time. That was good. We have a spreadsheet of the results which will be available for viewing very soon. Thanks for a much appreciated effort.

HOUSEHOLD HINTS

Many of you may have access to “The Ultimate Book of Household Hints”, a book which is really the mini - biography of thousands of people who have triumphed over a stream of domestic disasters.

These hints you are about to read give every one of us a chance to triumph over those domestic disasters - me included!!!

CREAMING BUTTER AND SUGAR– Before beating butter and sugar together, especially in winter time, stand beaters of your mixer in hot water. It quickens the process and butter does not stick to them.

CABBAGE– avoiding that smell

Add a crust of bread to cabbage or other strong-smelling vegetables while cooking.

Or, add a thick slice of lemon to cabbage or onions to prevent cooking smells.

EGG SUBSTITUTES IN CAKES - When short of eggs for a cake mix, try a tablespoon of milk mixed with a level dessertspoon of custard powder.

Or, add a tablespoon of custard powder for every 500gram of flour. Then only 1 egg is needed instead of 3.

CAKE TINS– Next time you buy a cake tin, grease and heat in the oven for 15 mins. It should never rust.

SOFTENING STIFF JEANS– Dissolve 2 dessertspoons of borax in 2 1/2 litres of hot water. When cool, put the jeans in this mixture and leave until next day. Rinse in hot water, then wash in usual way.

Or, before washing jeans for the first time, soak for 24 hours in a strong solution of salt and hot water. Use 220gram of salt to 1 bucket of hot water. Wash in normal way. Jeans never fade after this, nor do they run.

To remove **PERSPERATION ODOUR**– Dissolve 2 heaped tablespoons of bicarb of soda in 3/4 bucket full of cold or lukewarm water. Soak garments for 1 hour and then wash as usual. This is effective on all garments made from man made fibre.

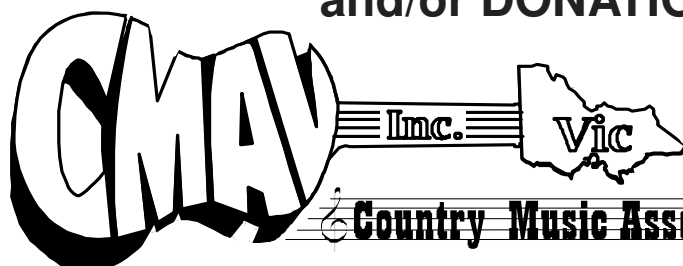
