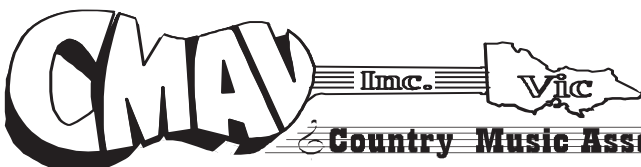

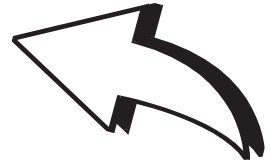

Nathaniel is Tracey's brother. At just 17 years of age, he boasts an impressive list of accomplishments including current Junior Grand Overall winner at the CCMA in Tamworth 2013, thus securing himself a scholarship at the Academy of Country Music in 2014. In May 2012 he was chosen to represent Australia in the Australian Showcase at the celebrated Norfolk Island Country Music Festival. This was the first time that a junior from South Australia had been selected for the Showcase, so this was a great honour for Nathaniel. His mature and professional presentation drew appreciation from audiences and industry representatives alike. Nathaniel held the South Australian Junior Champ of Champs title in 2010 – 2011, and has won numerous other awards in South Australia and interstate. He also qualified for the Queensland Champ of Champs after competing in the 2012 "Voice of Urban" Festival, where he came in a close 2nd. As with Tracey, his accomplishments are far too many to write about on one page.

Nathaniel has developed a standing among peers and audiences for his diverse vocal capacity and his uncanny ability to harmonize. This talent has seen him support accomplished artists both on the stage and in the studio.

He has become a favourite "son" with circuit followers, many of whom have watched him grow both as a performer and as a person. His voice has the ability to make a crowd sit up and take notice, and his stage presence is emotive with great depth of expression and refreshing honesty. Easy Sponge Pudding in the Microwave

Ingredients

Serves : 4

60g butter or margarine

60g caster sugar

60g self raising flour

1 medium egg, beaten

2 tablespoons milk

2 tablespoons of jam or golden syrup

Directions

Preparation: 10min › Cook: 3min › Ready in: 13min

In a medium bowl, cream together the butter and sugar until smooth. Mix in the egg and milk gradually, so as not to curdle the mixture. Sift in the flour, and fold in gently.

Put 2 tablespoons of raspberry jam or golden syrup in bottom of microwave-safe bowl. Pour in the mixture.

Cover and cook for 3 minutes on full power, or until the pudding appears set when gently shaken and the top is sticky. Serve hot with custard or cream.

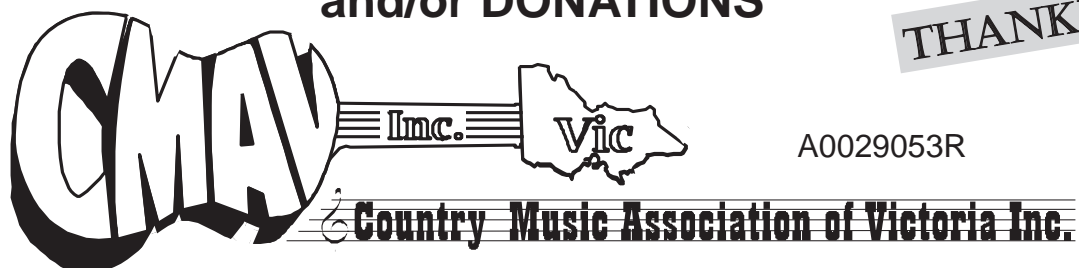
