RECIPE

Beef and Bacon Pot Pie

Ingredients:

2 tbsp olive oil - 800g chuck or gravy beef, cut into 4cm pieces

4 middle bacon rashers, trimmed and cut into 2cm pieces

1 brown onion chopped - 2 carrots chopped

150 g button mushrooms sliced - 1 dried bay leaf

¼ cup dry red wine - 420g can condensed tomato soup

1 sheet frozen puff pastry, partially thawed - 2 tbsp milk

Method:

Preheat oven to 160°C or 140°C fan-forced.

Heat half oil in a large heavy-based flame-proof casserole over medium high heat. Cook beef in batches, for 5 mins, or until browned, adding extra oil if necessary. Transfer to a bowl.

Heat remaining oil in dish. Add bacon and onion. Cook, stirring for 8 to 10 mins or until onion softens.

Add carrot and mushroom. Cook, stirring occasionally for 5 mins or until mushroom is tender. Return beef to dish with bay leaf, wine and soup.

Bring to a simmer.

Transfer dish to oven. Bake for 1½ hours or until beef is just tender. Remove from oven.

Transfer to an 8 cup-capacity metal dish.

Increase oven to 180°C or 160°C fan-forced. Place pastry over filling, allowing it to overhang. Trim edge. Brush with milk.

Bake for 30 mins or until pastry is golden. Stand 10mins.

Serve with Green beans and mashed potatoes.

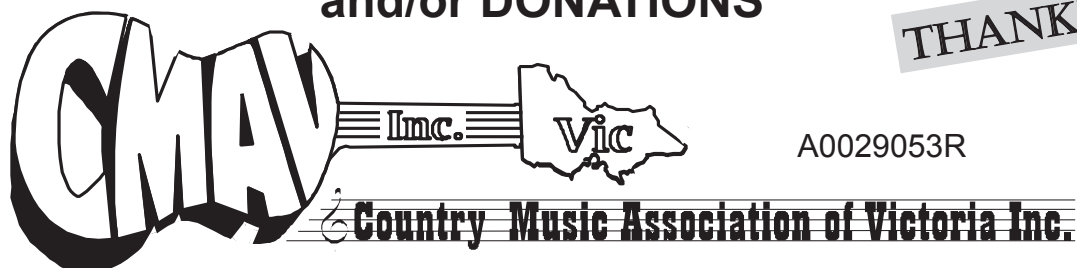
