He was diagnosed with cardiomyopathy, an illness which causes scarring and weakness of the heart muscle. He was on life support to begin with, and is now undergoing intensive therapy, and remains in a critical condition.

We wish him well.

In last months Ramblings I wrote about Dale Duncan's "Miracle Girl", and how he almost lost his baby Pheobe when she was born prematurely - she weighed just one pound one ounce - and with the incredible help of a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, little Pheobe struggled for 11 weeks but she survived. Now Dale Duncan and Johanna Hemara have written a duet, called "Miracle Girl". The CD can be bought for \$5.00 + \$3.00 postage and the money will go to support the Miracle Babies Foundation. Our Club has made a donation to the Ballarat Neonatal Unit - perhaps we should make another one.

Of major concern right now is Little Joy. She remains in hospital waiting for a bed at the Queen Elizabeth Rehab Centre. She is not really happy, and is missing her little unit. However, at this moment she needs full time care.

Warm wishes to all our "sickies" - get well soon. For a small "down under" country we certainly don't miss out on the big names in country music. At present we have tours up and coming from Taylor Swift, Charley Pride and Alan Jackson - not bad for starters.

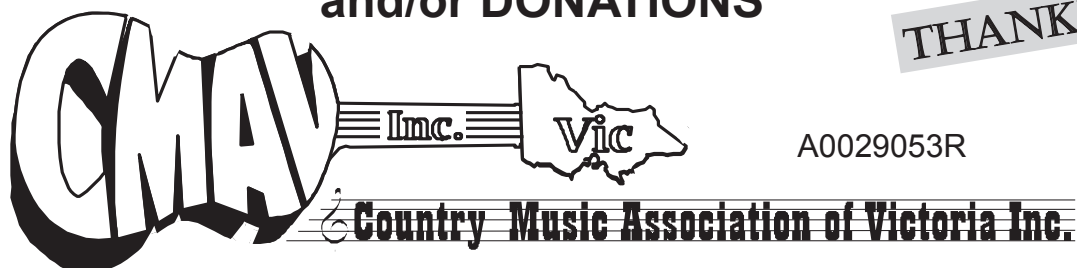
