3 tbsp lemon juice

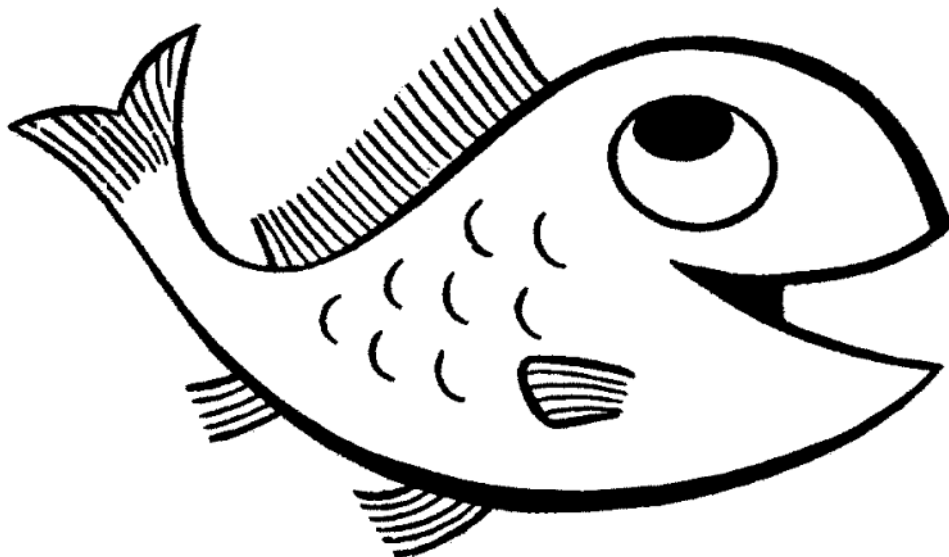
1 egg, beaten - extra
