We have a great band - Deanne, Peter, Darryl and Grant - they back our great walk-ups, and our monthly guest artists.

A light supper is available for a minimal price. Our kitchen ladies start at the club at 2:30 pm to spend two and a half hours making fresh sandwiches and cutting up cake, and we must be grateful to them. I have received some great feedback about the January Club night, and our guest artist Robyn Gleeson ; this is always good to hear.

Our guest artist tonight is Trevor Keilar– he comes from Warrnambool, has been singing and performing for just a few short years, with his Tribute show to Johnny Cash proving to be very popular.

For some time now, rumours have been floating around about a tour by Garth Brooks - well, he has now announced that he will be doing a world tour in 2014 - no actual dates or countries have been announced as yet. It is a good thing that so many of these big name artist want to visit Australia, but my heart lies with the Aussie performers - the ones that stay home, entertain us so very aptly, and keep their feet on Aussie soil!!!

The Tamworth Country Music Festival is over for another year, There is always an incredible build up to this event, and there seems to be a never-ending list of performers. I have never been to Tamworth, so I cannot make any comments, However I have been told that it is now “too big”, “more impersonal” and one has to “wait for ages to get into a venue”. On the other side of the coin, I hear that it was “just fantastic”, and “January 2015 cannot come soon enough” So there you have it!!

Lindsay butler and Shaza Leigh are very well-known across Australia. Lindsay has won an OAM for his contribution to Australian music. At the Canberra Country Music Festival recently, Shaza won 3 awards, and Lindsay was presented with the 2013 Lifetime Achievement Award. Lindsay and Shaza hope to make it to Ballarat in May of this year. I love their music - they are so professional; more of this at a later date.

Our daughter Katie and her partner Jeff are in Robina Queensland checking out their Steakhouse Restaurant up there. They are travelling and living in a huge truck which they have fitted out like a mobile home, including a shower, toilet, even a washing machine and dryer.

RECIPE

Bakewell Squares

INGREDIENTS:

Plain Flour, 1 cup. Butter, 75g, cold, chopped
Caster Sugar, 1 1/2 tablespoons. Egg, 1, separated
Cold Water, 1/2 teaspoon. Raspberry Jam, 1/2 cup
Flaked Almonds, 1/4 cup

FILLING:

Butter, 150g, softened. Caster Sugar, 2/3 cup
Lemon Zest, finely grated, 1 teaspoon
Eggs, 3. Almond Meal, 1 1/2 cups

METHOD:

- 1. Preheat oven to moderate, 180 degrees. Lightly grease and line a 20cm square pan with baking paper.**
- 2. In a food processor, combine flour, butter and sugar. Process until**
- 3. mixture resembles bread crumbs. Add egg-yolk and water, pulsing until dough comes together. Press dough evenly over pan base.**
- 4. Bake blind 15-20 minutes, until base is firm and pale golden. Remove paper and weights. Brush with whisked egg-white. Bake 1-2 minutes. Cool slightly.**
- 5. Reduce oven to moderately slow, 160 degrees. Spread jam evenly over slice base.**
- 6. FILLING: in a bowl, using an electric mixer, beat butter, sugar, zest and essence together, until creamy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well**
- 7. after each addition. Fold in almond meal. Carefully spread over jam. Bake 20 minutes.**
- 8. Remove pan from oven, sprinkle with almonds. Bake a further 15-20 minutes, until cooked when tested. Cool completely in pan.**
- 9. Cut into squares, store in an airtight container for 1 week**
