Our guest artist was Trevor Keilar, and he put on a great performance, proving to be very popular with our audience, both listeners and dancers. We are also very lucky with our walk-ups. We always have at least 15 artists, and they provide us with some good entertainment. It would be nice if EVERYBODY could show their appreciation by actually cutting the noise and LISTENING TO THE MUSIC. I know this only applies to certain tables, not all.

During this last month we have experienced all types of weather - I still prefer the warmer weather, but just not over 40*c. Last week I travelled to Ararat to hear David and Heather Hoffman entertain at the Performing Arts Centre. It was a good show, and the venue was full to overflowing. It was good to see some of the CMAV members there; they surely do love their country music!!!

Heather mentioned that they had been to Alcheringa very recently . It was a totally outdoor affair, and the temperature reached 47*c - now that is hot!!! Morning Melodies at Webbcona was an interesting day. Cameron Mason was unable to be there because of recent carpal tunnel surgery, so Rob Swanton and Dennis Bruce were asked if they could help out at very short notice. I was really pleased to see how well they were accepted, and my congratulations and thanks to a very loyal and receptive audience for their support of some "local talent".

Feedback was all good - Rob and Dennis did well.

Dennis and I were invited to a country music dance at Leonard's Hill - Dennis to compere and sing, and it was a lovely night.

The Hall is small and a little isolated but it certainly comes to life with all the music and dancing, followed by a truly lovely supper and a brew of coffee that stands alone, and not surprisingly there were CMAV members there as well!!

Elaine Howard has been organizing this dance for 41 years, Not a night for everyone, but I enjoy all kinds of music, and there were several very interesting acts that night.

Mavis turned 93 the next day– 17th February. Speaking of birthdays, a long time member of the CMAV, Iris Turnbull, had her 80th birthday on 6th March. Iris was a former Assistant Secretary of our Club and she used to make beautiful cakes for our suppers - my favorites were her jelly cakes!! She was devastated by the loss of her husband in 2009. Ron and Iris introduced Dennis to Country and Bluegrass music, and CMAV. He was a good man, and Dennis and I feel very privileged to have known him. Iris did not come to the club for a long time, but with help and encouragement from her good friend, Joan Dickins, and others, she is once again a capable and independent lady who looks after her property, tending to her garden, her cattle, and her chooks!!

Happy Birthday, Iris, from all of us - it is lovely to have you back with us, and enjoying your country music.

Congratulations to Peter and Helen Jeffrey. On Sunday 2nd March, they celebrated their 40th Wedding anniversary - that is always good news, but I have to say neither of them look really old enough to have clocked up that many years!! Well done.

I am told that there were some good artists at Barham, the names most mentioned being Sandie Dodd, Annette and Kim (from New Zealand), Jon Nicholson, Justin Standley, and a gentleman by the name of Rick Charles, who, I believe, "stole the show". Many thanks to those who gave me this information, and also brought cards back to me; it is much appreciated.

Helen Stewart is on the organizing committee of the Kilmore Country Festival. She was very happy with the event on the 2nd March. The weather was perfect, and there was an exceptional line-up of artists - Tim Farren, Amber Joy Poulton, Lee Forster and Baylou, to name just a few. I believe the whole day was excellent.

Dennis was guest artist at Colac Heritage and he was well received. This is just a small affair, but it is very homely and everyone listens to all the artists, so it is definitely a show with a difference. The songs are mostly traditional, and the evening closes with all the artists together on stage. Really pleasant.

Generally speaking, the daily news can be pretty awful. One story is about a Queensland schoolgirl bashed by a student in front of peers, and parents dropping off their children, while another student passively filmed the whole event. No one went to help but all the filming went on to YouTube as entertainment. I read an interesting article recently where a particular and principled person asked "where are people's morals" that they stand by and let this happen - this is "appalling bystander apathy." She wrote on social media, stating that it "engages people in a social vacuum where anonymity fuels the capacity to act maliciously and cruelly without consequence". She completes her article by saying that "the ethical health of our society badly needs an overhaul" and this is so true. So much for modern technology. In many cases, fear is the big prevention to stepping in to help, so one has to ask "what is the answer" ?

I feel sure that most people would be aware of the Civic Hall dilemma. The Civic Hall was built in the early to mid-fifties. In 1956, fifteen hundred people attended the opening concert, and this was followed over the years by many different types of entertainment - eg. Begonia Festival, musicals, artists - overseas and local, debutante balls, dances, trade shows, and the list goes on and on. I also know that country music singer Trevor Gleeson and his band CHIODO had big concerts there.

I also know that Trevor would do it again in a heart beat !!!

A continuing increase in charges brought about closure of the hall by Ballarat Council in 2002, and the building, I believe, has not been used since then. A proposal by the Council to demolish the building brought on much community reaction.

In our audience here tonight is a lady by the name of Veronica Punshon. She is very involved with the Civic Hall debate, and she would very much like people to speak briefly with her and give her just a few details of their memories and feelings about the Civic Hall. Please feel free to speak with her - she is very approachable, but it would be appreciated if this did not happen during the guest artist's performance.

I had better finish now for two reasons - lack of space, and I don't want to bore you.

To all our "sickies" and I know of several, please take care and get well soon. Our thoughts are with you. Until we meet again, I am

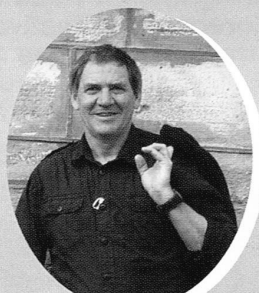

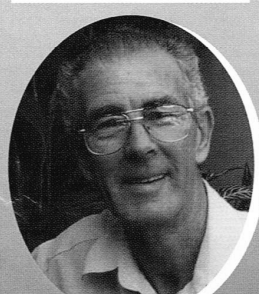

RECIPE

Lamb, Vegetable & Barley Soup

- 2 teaspoons olive oil
 - 500g lamb shoulder steaks, trimmed, cut into 2cm pieces
 - 1 brown onion, finely chopped
 - 2 garlic cloves, crushed
 - 1/2 cup pearl barley
 - 1 sprig fresh rosemary
 - 1 litre chicken stock
 - 1 parsnip, peeled, diced
 - 1 small orange sweet potato, peeled, diced
 - 1 small zucchini, diced
 - 2 yellow button squash, diced
- **Step 1** - Heat 1 teaspoon oil in a saucepan over high heat. Add lamb. Cook, stirring, for 5 to 7 minutes or until browned.
- Transfer to a plate.
- **Step 2** - Reduce heat to medium-high. Add remaining oil to pan. Add onion and garlic. Cook, stirring, for 3 minutes or until softened. Add lamb, barley, rosemary, stock and 1 1/2 cups cold water. Cover and bring to the boil. Reduce heat to medium low. Simmer, covered, for 1 hour or until lamb is tender.
- **Step 3** - Add parsnip, potato, zucchini and squash. Simmer, covered, for 15 to 20 minutes or until vegetables are tender. Season with pepper. Serve.

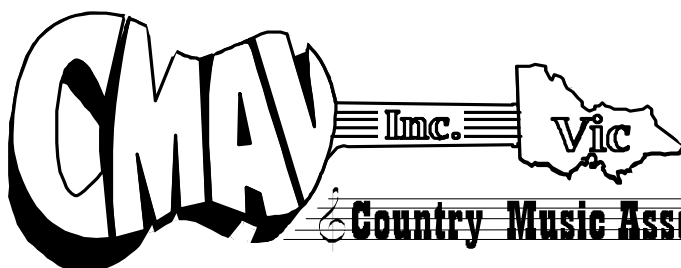
