**It was a good night, but the drive home was a slow one because it rained continuously.**

**On Sunday, Maryborough Club night had Leah Briggs as their guest artist. I am told that she was quite popular. She herself was very happy with the backing band. She will be our guest artist in a few months time. Last month an interesting article turned up in the newsletter of another club. It was headed "Karaoke or not Karaoke" with a sub-heading "Backing Tracks or No Backing Tracks". The writer obviously feels quite strongly about certain points. He finds it frustrating to pay good money to see artists perform and the first thing they do when they walk on stage is to plug in their Ipad or Laptop and start singing along to backing tracks.**

**The writer does not mind the artist who gets up with backing tracks while playing an instrument and singing. He feels it is the audience that decides in which direction the musician goes. If the audience accepts more and more artists using backing tracks, then more and more musicians will disappear, and we will be left with a long line of karaoke singers!!!**

**Sometimes, if you watch closely, you will notice that some guitars are not plugged in, and some artists only pretend to play guitar!!!**

**I found this article interesting and thought provoking, and so I decided to share it with you.**

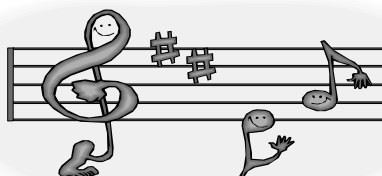

# RECIPE

## BEAN BREAD BASKETS

### Ingredients:

12 slices wholemeal bread

2 tblsp melted butter

420g can baked beans

3 cheddar cheese slices

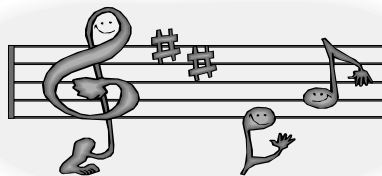
### Method:

1. Preheat oven to 180°C.
2. Trim the crusts from the bread slices and use a rolling pin to roll the slices thin. Brush one side with butter.
3. Press buttered side down into 12 hole muffin tin.
4. Bake for 10-12 minutes until golden and crisp
5. Spoon the beans evenly between bread cases.

Lightly whisk the eggs and pour over beans.

Tear the cheese slices into pieces and place them on top of each case.

6. Bake for a further 10 minutes until hot and golden.
