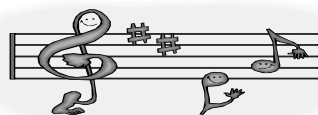
Many of you have known her since she was just a toddler– thanks always for your caring interest. Will keep you posted.

# RECIPE

## STICKY DATE PUDDING

### INGREDIENTS

#### PUDDING

250g pitted dates, chopped  
1 teaspoon bicarbonate of soda  
1 1/2 cups boiling water  
125g butter, softened  
1 cup brown sugar  
1 3/4 cups White Wings self-raising  
flour, sifted

#### Caramel Sauce

1 cup brown sugar  
300ml thickened Cream  
1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract  
60g Butter

### METHOD:

Step 1. Preheat oven to 180°C. Grease and line the base of a 7cm deep, 22cm (base) cake pan.

Step 2. Place dates and bicarb of soda into a bowl. Pour over boiling water. Allow to stand for 20 minutes.

Step 3. Using an electric mixer, beat butter, sugar and vanilla until pale and creamy. Add eggs, 1 at a time, beating well after each addition. Using a large metal spoon, fold through date mixture and flour until well combined.

Step 4. Spoon mixture into prepared cake pan. Bake for 35 to 40 minutes or until a skewer inserted into the centre comes out clean. Turn on to plate.

Step 5. Make sauce, combine all ingredients in a saucepan over medium heat. Cook, stirring often, until sauce comes to the boil. Reduce heat to medium-low, Simmer for 2 minutes.

Step 6. Pierce pudding all over with skewer. Pour 1/2 cup of warm sauce over warm pudding. Stand for 10 minutes. Cut into wedges. Serve with remaining sauce.
