Faye Thompson was also a gentle soul, who always thought of others before herself.

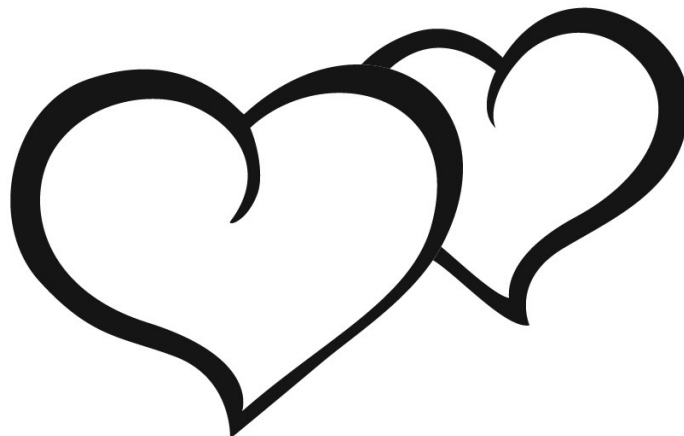
David Grisinger fought long and hard against a disease that knows no boundaries, and his partner Annette was there every step of David's journey.

It is said that time helps in the healing process—for all those concerned, we truly hope that this bears truth.



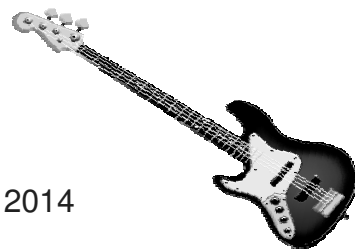

RECIPE

HOMEMADE SAUSAGE ROLLS

INGREDIENTS

1 Kg Hamburger Mince,
1 Kg sausage mince,
2 carrots, grated,
1 brown onion, diced,
1 bunch parsley,
1 egg

5 cloves garlic, chopped
1/2 cup Worcestershire sauce
1/4 cup tomato sauce
2 Packets of Puff Pastry
1 cup milk

METHOD

Step 1 - Preheat oven to 180-200°C

Step 2– Grate the carrots, finely chop the brown and red onions, finely dice 5 cloves of garlic, finely chop 1/2 a cup of parsley. Mix all this together in a bowl and set aside.

Step 3 - In a large bowl combine 1Kg of hamburger mince and 1Kg of sausage mince, add Worcestershire sauce and tomato sauce.

Work mixture with your hands until combined. Start adding the onions, carrots, parsley and garlic to the meat mixture. Use a little or as much of this mixture as you desire, but it does taste better with lots of the onion-carrot mix!!

Step 4 - Add 1 egg to 1/2 cup of milk and whisk. Set this aside

Step 5 - Take a piece of puff pastry and cut in half. Place the meat mixture along one side of a piece of puff pastry. Make the meat mixture the same thickness as a thin pork sausage.

Step 6 - Once the mixture is in place, run a fork along the other edge of the puff pastry, rub the egg and milk mix along the mark the fork made and roll the pastry into a closed tube. Rub the egg and milk mix on top of the sausage rolls. (as big or small as you like) A good size is about 4 cm per sausage roll.

Step 7 - Lay the finished sausage rolls on a greased baking tray, and bake in the oven for about 15 minutes or until golden brown. Repeat this process until all mixture is used.
