RECIPE

TRIPLE CHOC BROWNIES

INGREDIENTS

125g butter, chopped
1/2 cup (95g) NESTLE White CHOC BITS
375g pkt NESTLE Dark Melts
1/2 cup (95g) NESTLE Dark CHOC BITS
1/2 cup (110g) caster sugar
1/2 cup (95g) NESTLE Milk CHOC BITS
2 eggs, lightly beaten
1 tbsp vegetable oil
1 1/4 cups (185g) plain flour

METHOD

Step 1. Preheat oven to 180°C fan forced. Grease and line base and sides of a 19cm square cake pan.

Step 2. Melt butter, 1 1/3 cups NESTLE Dark Melts and sugar in large saucepan over low heat; stir continuously until melted. Cool 10 minutes.
