






CONGRATULATIONS

Our guest artist last month was Kim Ritchie. She was very happy to be back with us again after a period of at least three years. It is just as well that she has a very strong voice because ,once again, the noise was pretty ugly. I know that many of you do not see each other between club nights, and so it is lovely to " catch up " and that is fine, but surely it would not hurt any one of us to show a little respect and simply stop the talking while the artists are performing. It must be so disconcerting to sing to a totally and seemingly disinterested and talkative audience. Just imagine if you were that person on stage. !!!!!!! I know that I am generalising because there are many people who DO try to listen ,who do go to the CMAV nights because they have a real love of music. Perhaps we should just forget the music, get together for tea, coffee and sandwiches and have a full-on chat. It is not always the fault of the audience. Sometimes a guest artist will talk too much between songs, and sometimes the walk-up artists are not as prepared as they should be. These factors allow time for the talking to take over. Our Comperes--Ron and Dennis--do an excellent job appealing to everyone and this does have an effect , but it is short-lived. So what is the answer? Do we adopt Beaufort Club's approach and simply stop the music when the noise is too much, or perhaps our breaks could be slightly longer. Ron and Dennis keep to a schedule so the evening runs relatively smoothly, and all the walk-ups get a chance to perform. So, if anyone has some constructive criticism and/or fresh ideas, your Committee would love to hear from you, and so you have our thanks in anticipation...

Morning Melodies at Webbcona Bowls Club was well attended and certainly worth attending. Cameron Mason was the guest artist. His beautifully smooth voice and choice of songs never fails to please. 

RECIPE

BUTTER CAKE

INGREDIENTS:



1 Large Vanilla Bean

1/2 cup Cornflour


200ml Full Cream Milk

2 cups Self Raising Flour

1 1/2 Caster Sugar

200gms Unsalted Butter

4 Eggs



METHOD:

Step 1. Preheat oven to 200 Degrees Celcius.

Step 2. Cut down the length of the vanilla bean, and scrape out the seeds, place the vanilla seeds and milk into a 1.5 litre saucepan, gently heat until the milk has warmed, remove saucepan from the heat and set aside.

Step 3. Sift the flour and cornflour into a bowl, add sugar and stir well, whisk the vanilla milk and eggs. When thoroughly combined add to flour mixture.

Step 4. Add butter and using electric beaters beat on high speed for 2mins, pour the batter into cake tin, and spread evenly.

Step 5. Bake for 50 minutes or until lightly golden and firm, stand for 5 minutes before turning onto a cake rack.

Step 6. Cool completely before topping with icing if desired.
