RECIPE

FISH CURRY

INGREDIENTS

3/4 cup Olive Oil	2 tsp Paprika
1 Large Onion, Sliced	1.5 tsp Turmeric Powder
1 Tblsp finely chopped Ginger	1/2 cup Chicken stock
2 Cloves fresh Garlic, thinly sliced	400g Blue Eye Cod, Skinned and cut into 4cm cubes
1 tsp Sea Salt	3/4 cup Plain Yoghurt
1.5 tsp Garam Masala	20ml Lime Juice

METHOD

1. Heat Olive Oil in a small frying pan, add onion, ginger, garlic and salt and sweat over low-medium heat for 10-15 minutes.
2. Stirring occasionally, or until onion is soft and starting to Caramelize.
3. Add spices and cook, stirring constantly for 1-2 minutes or until Aromatic.
4. Add stock and simmer for 5-10 minutes.
5. Add fish to pan and stir gently to cover fish with sauce and simmer for 2 minutes.
6. Add yoghurt and lime juice, remove from heat and stir gently.
7. Serve with steamed rice,
