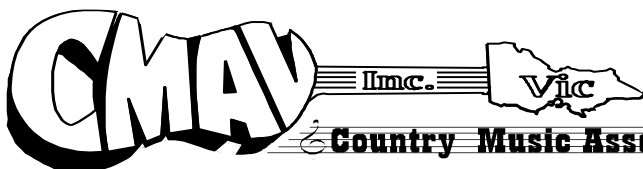

Connie-Kis Andersen comes from Bentley, a suburb of beautiful Perth. She is visiting us on her way through to the Tamworth Country Music Festival and we are delighted to have her perform for us.

With a reputation as one of Western Australia's finest country music artists and singer songwriters, Connie Kis has managed to overcome the 'tyranny of distance' through her hard work ethic, commitment to her dream and her willingness to tour relentlessly to promote her music.

Connie has been the recipient of multiple awards- both in song writing and as an artist. Highlights include being named Western Australia's Best Country Female Artist three times, winning the 'Best Independent Country Music Album for W A twice, and receiving an Australian Tiara for Female Vocalist. She released her 5th CD album just last November, calling it "Naked under the Radar". A single from this album 'On the Other Side of Midnight' reached #4 on the Country Tracks Top 40.

Facing some of the treacherous twists and turns that life's highway has taken her down, including a serious bout with Stage 3 cancer, Connie -Kis reveals her deep belief in self. I have found her to be a delightful person to converse with, an inspiring woman who really shines as an example for others to never lose sight of their dreams. RECIPE

TUNA MORNAY

Step 2 - Add flour and gradually add milk and water simultaneously until desired thickness of sauce is achieved.

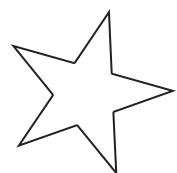
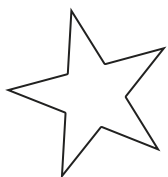
Step 3 - Add cheese to sauce.
