With Xmas and New Year behind us for another year we can look forward to, and hope for good health, happiness and lots of great country music and events, especially right here.!!!!!! I think we have made a pretty good beginning to 2015 with our January guest artist, Connie Kis Andersen. I have had some really good feedback about her performance, and she certainly kept the dancers busy, which is always a pretty good indication. Thanks to all those members who expressed their appreciation and enjoyment. It is very refreshing to hear such positive comments. !!!!! I received an e-mail from Connie a couple of days after she left Ballarat. She thanked me for inviting her to our Club and she expressed her appreciation to our Band for their backing, and to the entire audience for making her feel so very welcome, so, much credit to you all.

Our guest artist tonight is Don Costa, who is very well known in the fields of country music. Several years ago he and his family moved from Victoria and they are now settled on the Sunshine Coast in Queensland. He has a great voice and an easy going personality. He relates very well to his audiences providing them with a great selection of old traditional favourites, from country ballads across the board to country rock. If you have not heard this man perform before then you are in for a really pleasant surprise. I have been told that in 2011 he was immortalised in the Country Music Hall of Fame by placing his hand in a concrete guitar. This happened in Barmera during the 33rd South Australian Country Music Festival and New Talent Awards Night. How special is that ?!!!!

Our belated congratulations to you Don.

Australia Day was well catered for this year with, it seemed, more events than in previous years--there was something for all tastes and interests. Dennis and I escaped the crowds and travelled to Barwon Heads at the kind invitation of some truly lovely friends and we had a great day with lots of sunshine, food, laughter and music. Barwon Heads is a very pretty and popular seaside resort and the Main Street was alive with a variety of interesting eateries and some very quaint little gift shops. It is situated at the mouth of the Barwon River and was the location for the very popular ABC television series "SeaChange". It is also home to some very classy-looking golf courses. A lovely place.

I believe that the fireworks display by Lake Wendouree was pretty spectacular. I have always loved firecrackers and such-I think I must have a touch of the Pyromaniac in me.!!!.

I am not very good with technology but for Xmas I was given an I-pad by my family, so with the help of several very patient people, I am slowly learning how to use it, but just baby steps so far. However when reading Facebook recently, I learned that on Australia Day our own Peter and Helen Jeffrey loaded two utilities with hay donated by farmers in the Ararat region and they then drove to Moyston to give this hay to those in need following recent ravaging fires. I believe that there was quite a convoy of vehicles similarly involved. How good is that?!!! Well done guys and sincere thanks to the farmers who donated the hay.

The Tamworth Country Music Festival is over again for another year and from what I hear it was a pretty popular event as always. The Golden Guitar Awards are the main focus of all contenders and the list of winners is lengthy and quite interesting, but I will just make mention of the main ones. Luke O'Shea has taken out no less than 3 Golden Guitar Awards, including Heritage Song of the Year for the 3rd consecutive time, Male Artist of the Year and Apra Song of the Year, with a song he wrote called "Three Brothers" (The Great War) with the intention of reminding people of the incredibly large number of young men who lost their lives in the First World War. Luke feels that it was a horrible tragedy that should never be forgotten, an opinion shared by many. Female Artist of the Year went to Amber Lawrence, her 1st Golden Guitar for her 4th Album called "Superheroes". Kasey Chambers was awarded a Golden Guitar for Album of the Year with her album called "Bittersweet" and so the list goes on. Our congratulations to them all.

Just a few days after winning his Golden Guitars, Luke and his Father were arrested for their involvement in a protest at Whitehaven Coal's Maules Creek Mine near Narrabri in northwest NSW. They allegedly gained access to a secure water compound and O'Shea locked himself to the equipment. He and his Father claim that they are not anti-mining but they are anti-greed, and they feel that the people on the land out there need help.

Country music artist Royden Donohue was guest artist at our Club in 2013 and then at Beaufort. Driving home that night he was making a right hand turn into a rest area when a semi-trailer wiped out Royden's caravan and a large part of his car. To this day he finds it hard to understand why he survived and he still has the occasional nightmare. Recently Royden's wife Kelly gave birth to their fifth daughter and we are very happy for them. A card has been sent to them on our behalf.

The Fifth Annual Terang Country Music Festival will be held at the Terang Racecourse from 13th-15th March. A bush ballad show will be held on Friday night with Dean Perrett and other guests at the racecourse, and there will be free music in the Terang Hotel. Saturday morning begins with a poet's brekky, followed by music all day with Roo Arcus, Stuie, Camille and Sonny French, The Sherrahs, Grandsons of the Pioneers, Leah Briggs, Marie Hodson, and The Davidson Brothers. RECIPE

ORANGE AND LEMON SYRUP CAKE.

Ingredients:

3 lemons - 3 oranges - 6 eggs, lightly beaten
2¾ cup (685g) caster sugar - 1½ cups (375ml) milk
250g unsalted butter, chilled and chopped
3 cups (375g) S.R. Flour, sifted.

Method:

1. Preheat oven to warm 160°C . Grease a 24 cm springform tin and line the base and sides with baking paper. Finely grate rind from the lemons and oranges to give 3 tbs of each. Squeeze the lemons and oranges to give ¾ cup (185ml) from each. Heat the butter, 2 cups (500g) caster sugar, 1tbs of each of lemon and orange rind in a saucepan over low heat, stirring until melted and combined. Transfer to a bowl.
2. Add half the egg, ¾ cup (185ml) of the milk and 1½ cups (185g) of the flour to the bowl, beating with electric beaters until just combined. Add the remaining egg, milk and flour and beat until smooth—do not overmix. Pour into the tin and bake for 1 hour 15 minutes, or until a skewer comes out clean when inserted into the centre of the cake—cover with foil if it browns too much. Cool in the tin.
3. To make the syrup, combine the lemon and orange juices, remaining lemon and orange rinds, remaining sugar and ½ cup (125ml) water in a saucepan and stir over low heat until the sugar has dissolved. Increase the heat and bring to the boil for ten minutes, or until it thickens and reduces slightly. Pour the hot syrup over the cool cake. Cool in the tin for 10 minutes then remove. Add some orange zest to the syrup in the last ten minutes , for garnish.
