

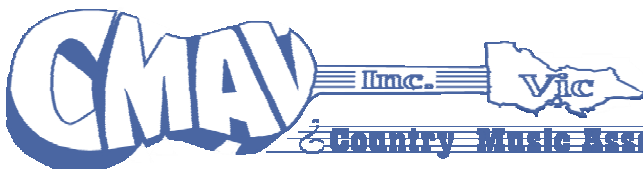

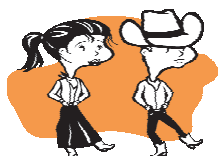

# RECIPE

## Chicken & Broccoli Casserole

Serves four.

### Ingredients:

400g /14oz broccoli florets - 40g /1½ oz butter  
1 onion thinly sliced  
350g /12 oz cooked chicken cut into bite-sized chunks  
100g /3½ oz crème fraiche - 200ml /7 fl oz chicken stock  
25g /1 oz fresh white breadcrumbs  
55g /2 oz Gruyère or Emmenthal cheese,  
grated - salt & pepper

### Method:

1. Preheat the oven to 200°C / 400°F /gas Mark 6.  
Bring a saucepan of lightly salted water to the boil, add the broccoli and cook for 5 mins until tender. Drain Well.
2. Meanwhile, melt 25g /1 oz of the butter in a frying pan, add the onion and stirfry over a medium heat for 3 - 4 mins until soft.
- 3 Layer the broccoli, onion and chicken in a 1.5-litre / 2¾ pint ovenproof dish and season well with salt & pepper. Pour over the crème fraiche and stock.
4. Melt the remaining butter in a small saucepan and stir in the breadcrumbs. Mix with the cheese and sprinkle over the dish.
5. Place the dish on a baking sheet in the pre-heated oven and bake for 20 - 25 minutes until golden brown and bubbling.
