Jilly's Ramblings..

A very warm welcome to our 243rd CMAV Club night. How nice the weather has been in recent weeks, a touch changeable but still good. He thinks that Lyall Wheaton does an excellent task of organising the whole weekend and it would seem that everything runs very smoothly. I know that there were some teething problems with the first couple of Festivals but Lyall and his crew persevered and that perseverance has paid off, so congratulations to all involved.

A number of CMAV members and patrons also attended the Tooleybuc Music Muster. Again opinions varied but for the most part it was pretty good. By all reports, some artists were definitely better than others but I guess that is to be expected.

A couple of long-time Club members travelled to Nowra in New South Wales to attend the Terara Country Music Festival. By all accounts it was a very good festival, in fact so good that Don and Muriel have already booked again for next year. There were no less than 270 caravans and mobile homes on site--sounds unreal. The Festival went for four very interesting days and nights.

The line-up of artists was quite impressive, including Laura Downing, Tom Maxwell, Jay Potger, Ernie Constance, Jeff Brown and Cameron Mason.

There seems to be an endless list of country music events over the remaining months of this year---festivals, clubs and cruises. I look forward to hearing about them.

Our Club BBQ was held on Sunday 29th March.

We could not have asked for nicer weather .

RECIPE

Salmon & Spinach Pie

(serves 4 - prep: 50 mins - cook: 35 mins)

Ingredients:

4 green spring onions - 415g can pink salmon, drained

1 tblsp lemon juice - 60g baby spinach leaves

1 cup sour cream - 1 tsp finely grated lemon rind

½ cup grated Tasty cheese.

Rice base:

1 cup long-grain white rice - ½ cup grated Tasty cheese

1 egg, lightly beaten - salt & pepper to taste.

Method:

- 1. Grease a 24cm round, ovenproof pie dish(6 cup capacity)**
- 2. To make base, cook rice according to instructions on packet until tender.**
- 3. Cook in a moderate oven(180C) for about 25 to 30 minutes, or until golden brown. Cool.**
- 4. Finely chop white part of onions and place in a large bowl. Finely chop the green tops of onions and set aside. Add salmon and juice to the bowl with white onions. Season with salt and pepper. Mix well.**
- 5. Arrange spinach over rice base. Top with salmon mixture. Spoon over combined cream and rind to cover salmon.**
- 6. Cook in a moderate oven(180C) for about 35 minutes, or until just set and golden brown. Stand for 15 minutes. Serve pie garnished with reserved green onion tops.**
