## RECIPE

### CHICKEN CORN CHOWDER IN BREAD BOWLS

#### Ingredients:

**1 tblsp oil - 1 finely chopped onion - 2 cups chicken stock**

**500g chicken thigh fillets cut into 2cm pieces**

**420g can creamed corn - 310g can corn kernels drained**

**500g peeled potatoes cut into 2cm pieces**

**2 sticks thinly sliced celery - 1 red capsicum cut into 2cm pieces**

**8 large round bread rolls - cooking oil spray - ¼ cup cream**

**½ cup chopped parsley - salt & pepper to taste.**

#### Method:

**Heat oil in a large saucepan. Add onion & chicken. Cook, stirring occasionally for about 5 mins, or until chicken is browned all over.**

**Add stock, creamed corn, corn kernels, potatoes, celery & capsicum. Bring to boil, simmer uncovered for about 30 mins, or until thickened and potato is soft.**

**Meanwhile, cut a 10cm wide circle from top of each roll. Remove bread from inside leaving 1cm thick shell. Reserve bread for another use. Place rolls and lids on an oven tray.**

**Spray all over with oil.**

**Cook in a hot oven (200°C) for about 10mins, or until golden brown.**

**Stir cream and parsley into hot soup and season.**

**To serve, place a warm bread bowl on each serving plate. Ladle in hot soup. Top with lids and serve immediately.**

**Tip: Coarsely chop left over bread and spray with cooking oil. Place in a single layer on an oven tray. Cook in a hot oven(200°C) for 5 to 8 mins, or until golden brown.**


