## **RECIPE - LEMON DELICIOUS PUDDING**



### **Ingredients:**

3 eggs  
1/2 cup sugar  
1 cup milk  
1 tbs self-raising flour  
1 tbs lemon rind grated  
1/2 cup lemon juice  
1tbs sugar

### **Method:**

**Step 1** - Separate eggs then beat yolks and sugar together in a small mixer bowl until light and creamy. Then add milk, lemon juice and rind, and fold in sifted flour.

**Step 2** - In a clean bowl, beat egg whites until soft peaks form. Add extra sugar and beat until dissolved.

**Step 3** - Fold into lemon mixture and pour into a greased casserole dish. Stand dish in a shallow pan of cold water and bake in a moderate oven for 50-60 minutes. Serve with ice cream.
