CALLUM GLEESON

Callum was born and raised in Kyabram in the Goulburn Valley region of country Victoria. He started singing at the very young age of 3 years and he made his first public appearance at the Mooroopna Country Music when he was just 9 years old. As you can imagine, his biography is an extensive one and far too lengthy to put into one page, but it is very interesting.

Callum developed a passion for country music and he wrote his first song when he was 11 years old, calling it "Lose You Again". This song went to No.38 of the Most Played Independent Country Music songs in the world.

As a young guy, he busked at the Victoria Market which led him to Tamworth. He then was accepted into , and became a graduate of the Tamworth Camerata Junior Country Music School, and so the achievements roll on. Callum has a rare musical talent. He knows hundreds of songs in a wide variety of musical genre. Whilst his passion is still country music , he can also "rock it up". He has a voice with a 3-octave range which means he can sing beautiful ballads and then launch into raunchy songs as well.

Last year Callum enjoyed great success in Vanuatu and also at the Bay of Islands Country Rock Festival in New Zealand. Back home he entertains at many Festivals as well as a variety of private functions.

He has released several CD's which will be available for purchase tonight.

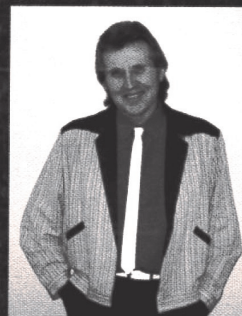

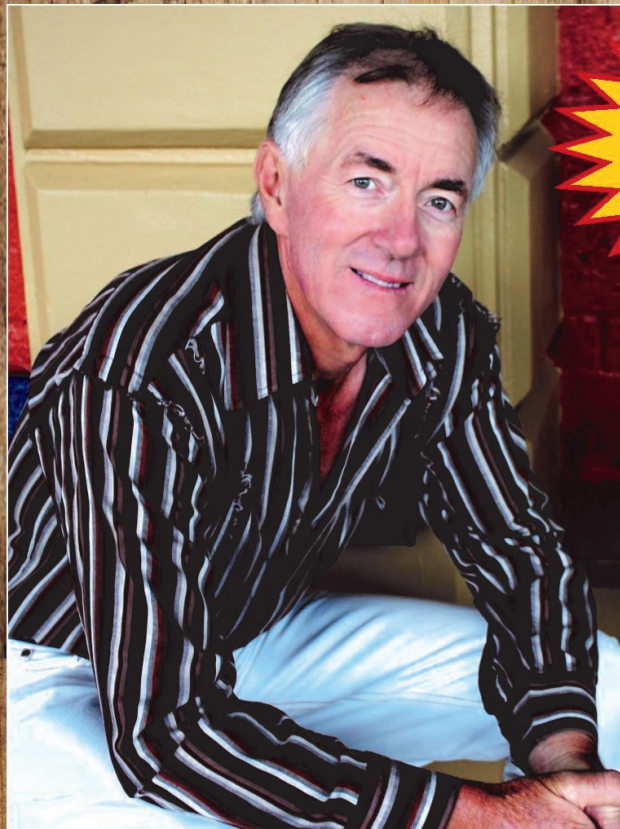

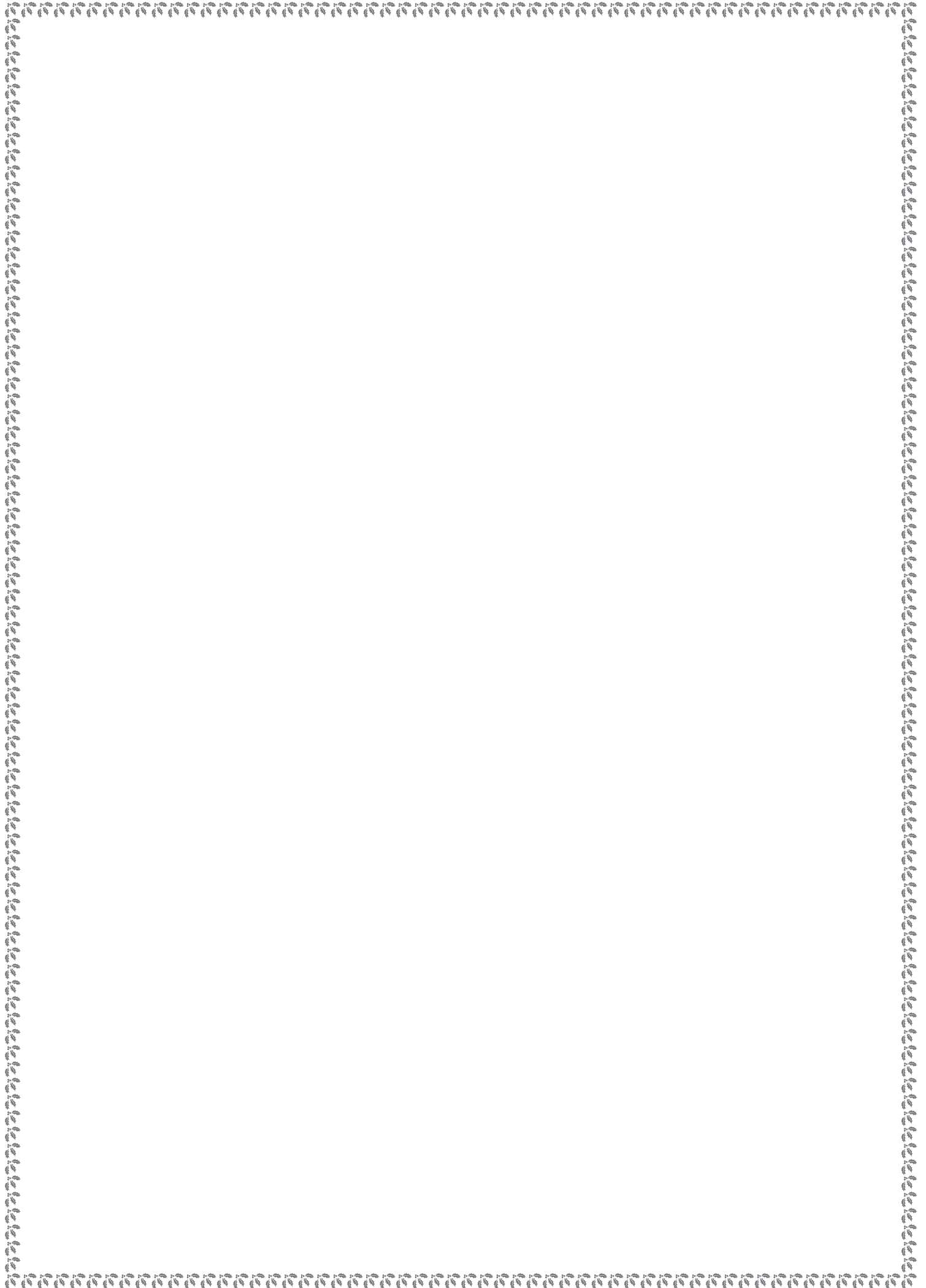
The passing of yet another **Musical Icon**.

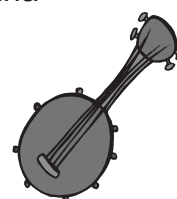

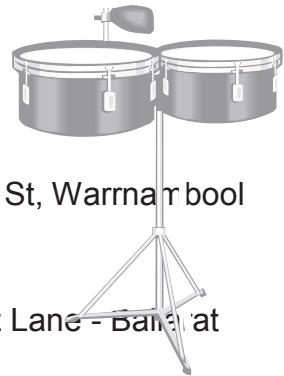

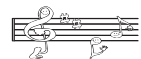

RECIPE - SAVOURY SCONES



Ingredients:

4 cups (600g) self-raising flour

Pinch cayenne pepper

100g chilled unsalted butter, cubed, plus
extra to serve

150g ham, finely chopped

6 springs onions, finely chopped

1/2 red capsicum, finely chopped

1/2 green capsicum, finely chopped

2 cups (240g) finely grated tasty cheese

1 1/2 cups (375ml) milk, plus extra to brush

Method:

Step 1 - Preheat the oven to 180°C fan-forced (200° conventional). Grease and flour a baking tray.

Step 2 - Sift the flour into a large bowl, add the cayenne pepper and rub the butter with your fingertips until it resembles fine breadcrumbs. Stir in the ham, spring onion, ham, capsicums and 1 1/2 cups of the tasty cheese, and season well with salt and pepper. Add the milk, cutting it into the dry mixture.

Step 3 - Place the mixture onto the prepared tray. Form into a flat round, about 25cm in diameter. Cut into eight wedges, then separate wedges slightly. Brush the top of the scones with extra milk and sprinkle over the remaining cheese. Bake for 20-25 minutes or until golden.

Step 4 - Serve warm, spread with extra butter..
