In some cases but definitely not all, DMD can be inherited. There is a young couple in Ballarat who have 3 sons and a daughter, and sadly all three sons have DMD. The concert had a strong country feel about it. Several of the artists who gave so freely of their time to help this family are either CMAV members or they have been here as very welcome walk-up artists, namely Dennis Bruce, Jim Lindsay, Les Smith, Andy Dee and Kenny Garrett . It was a good afternoon.

Kenny Smith lives in Koroit and on the last Sunday of every month in Warrnambool, he organises a Country Music Charity Concert. His most recent concert was on Sunday 30th October Along with Kenny and his Band, artists included The Durdins, Jim Lindsay and our own Dennis Bruce. Kenny, in all his generosity, never fails to invite me to talk about our CMAV . As a result let's give a warm welcome to some visitors from Gisborne, Wayne and Barbara, who did not even know that we existed until that concert!!!!

I have heard many good reports about the St. Arnaud Country Music Festival which was on from October 28th-30th. It seems that the entire weekend was really successful, with every day and evening well attended. Artists included Danny and Karen O'Brien, Leon Argent, Tracey Rains , Callum Gleeson, Pete Smith, Robyn Gleeson and Laurie Treloar, to name just a certain few. RECIPE - CHEESE SOUFFLES



Ingredients:

20G butter, melted, for greasing
100g butter, extra, chopped
1/2 cup plain flour
1 1/2 cups milk
1 cup grated extra tasty cheddar cheese
1/2 teaspoon Dijon mustard
4 large eggs, separated, at room temperature

Method:

Step 1 - Preheat the oven to 200°C/1 80°C fan forced. Grease 4 x 300mL, deep ramekins with melted butter. Place on a baking tray.

Step 2 - Melt chopped butter in a medium saucepan over medium heat. Add flour. Cook, stirring constantly, for 1 minute or until smooth and bubbling. Remove from heat. Gradually whisk in milk. Return to heat. Stir over medium-low heat until mixture is smooth and comes to the boil. Boil for 1 minute. Remove from heat. Set aside to cool for 5 minutes. Transfer mixture to a large bowl.

Step 3 - Whisk cheese, mustard and egg yolks into milk mixture. Season with salt and pepper. Using an electric mixer, beat egg whites in a separate bowl until soft peaks form. Using a large metal spoon, stir 1/4 egg white through cheese mixture. Gently fold in remaining egg white. Spoon into prepared dishes. Bake for 25 to 30 minutes until risen and golden. Serve immediately.
